

# Submitting your Sketch File

The sketch files you submit should be clear, legible and help us work out what you wish to achieve. Sketch files are drawings or computer models that need to be converted into machineable CAD files (such as ".3dm", if you are able to create and edit these files confidently please look at our "drawing considerations" document if you wish to submit a CAD file)

## Supplying your drawing as a sketch.

These can be as accurate as you like - ranging from 3rd/1st angle drawings to pencil sketches. These can be submitted as image files (either through scanning or exporting from a relevant software) then attached through our "Submit a job" section of our website. The following file types are preferable:-

1. ".jpg" ".png" (any universal image file that can easily be opened)
2. ".pdf" (Adobe PDF File) - common export file and universal across all Adobe programs, if using an adobe program such as Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop to sketch your design please refrain from sending the ".ai" or ".psd" instead using ".pdf"
3. Please note, if you wish to explain in detail your design, feel free to attach a text document ".doc" (Microsoft word document) ".pdf" (Adobe pdf) or ".txt" (notepad) files are acceptable

## Checking your files before submission

- Check there are dimensions (even if they are just an estimate) to give an idea of scale and help us provide you with a more accurate quote
